TUITION, FEES, DEPOSITS

All required tuition, fees, and deposits are due in full at the time of registration. A student is not registered and is not entitled to enter any class or laboratory until full payment is made. Payment may be made in cash or by check or money order payable to the University of Houston.

The University reserves the right to change without notice tuition, other charges, and related requirements and regulations as necessitated by University or legislative action.

Tuition

Tuition each fall and spring semester and summer term for all colleges at the University is based upon the number of hours for which the student registers. It is the student's responsibility to register under the proper resident or nonresident classification. See nonresident definition on pages 42-46.

Student Services Fee

A student services fee, as authorized by state law, is charged to every student. Each fall and spring semester the fee is based upon the number of hours for which the student registers, as follows:

Number of Hours Registered For	Student Services Fee
12 or more	\$ 20
9 - 11	18
5 - 8	13
1 - 4	8

During the summer, the student services fee is \$2 each 6-week term or \$4 for a 12-week term. In no case shall the amount charged each student exceed \$4 for the summer session.

If the student pays the student services fee for 12 or more hours in the fall and spring semesters, he is entitled to admission to athletic events and to a copy of the yearbook, *The Houstonian*. If, in the fall and spring semesters, the student pays less than the fee for 12 or more hours, these benefits are not included. Students taking less than 12 hours may elect to pay the full student services fee in order to be eligible for these activities.

University Center and Student Services Building Fees

The Board of Regents has levied a special compulsory fee to retire revenue bonds issued for construction of the University Center and the Student Services buildings, to be charged each student as follows:

Each fall and spring semester	\$10
Each six-week summer term	5
Twelve-week summer term	10

In no case shall the amount charged each student exceed \$6 for the summer session.

Academic Building Use Fees

Effective September 1, 1967, the Board of Regents has levied special compulsory building use fees to retire revenue bonds issued for construction of additional academic facilities, to be charged each student as follows:

Each six-week summer term	13	13

In no case shall the amount charged each student exceed \$20 for the summer session.

Parking Fee

A parking fee of \$7 each semester and \$3 each 6-week summer term or \$6 for a 12-week summer term will be assessed, at the time of registration, each student who operates a motor vehicle on the campus or on properties leased by the University. If a student has more than one vehicle to be registered, he must present the title of each vehicle, and a fee of \$1 will be charged for second and subsequent registrations.

If the student does not intend to operate a motor vehicle or cause a motor vehicle to be operated on the campus or properties leased, he may sign an affidavit to that effect at the time of registration and the fee will be waived. Operation
